



DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST:

- ◆ Passport Copy (Front and Back Page)
- ◆ Class 10th & 12th Marksheets
- ◆ Bachelor's Mark sheets and Transcripts (if any)
- ◆ Bachelor's Degree Certificate (if any)
- ◆ Statement of Purpose
- ◆ CV (Resume) Updated
- ◆ Medium of Instruction from University (if any)
- ◆ IELTS
- ◆ Letter of Recommendation (Two from the University)
- ◆ Work Experience Letters / Internship Letters (if any)

IMPORTANT POINTS:

- ◆ Scanned and clear PDF of the documents
- ◆ Gather official transcripts from all previous institutions
- ◆ Check the Visa Requirement and arrange all the necessary documents.
- ◆ Review the application guidelines carefully.



FINANCE REQUIRED:

Living Expense:

- 1,529 GBP per month (For up to 9 months) inside London (13,761 GBP)
- 1,171 GBP per month (For up to 9 months) outside London (10,539 GBP)

Tuition fees:

- Undergraduate: 14,400 GBP to 38,000 GBP
- Postgraduate: 15,000 GBP to 35,000 GBP

Accommodation:

- 150-400 GBP per week (Inside London)
- 110-300 GBP per week (Outside London)
